



Dear Valued Customer:

In October 2004, the Government of Alberta launched its new electronics recycling program, the first of its kind in Canada. The purpose of the program is to give Albertans access to collection sites and e-roundups in order to help them dispose of their old (or end-of-life) electronics, specifically computers and TVs so that they can be recycled. To date, more than 50 collection sites have been established across the Province.

The program is funded by an environmental fee (otherwise know as the Advance Disposal Surcharge) ranging from \$5 to \$45 on the purchase of computers and new TVs in Alberta starting February 1, 2005. The program is managed by the Alberta Recycling Management Authority (ARMA), a non-profit organization delegated by the Government of Alberta to manage the electronics recycling program on behalf of Albertans. As part of this process, we require all our Alberta based customers and customers who ship to Alberta sign the Remittance Certificate attached ASAP and fax to Ingram Micro at 905-755-1398 along with your New Account application. If we do not get a signed certificate, all customer shipments to Alberta will be charged the applicable fee. Product categories charged will include televisions, laptops/notebooks, printers/printer combos, desktops and monitors. Please also note that you must register and have a registration number with Electronics Recycling Alberta in order to make this remittance certificate valid.

If you have not yet registered, and/or plan on selling product in Alberta in the future, you should register right away. Further details of this program can be found at the website and number listed above.
